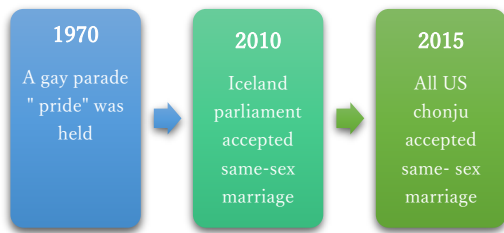


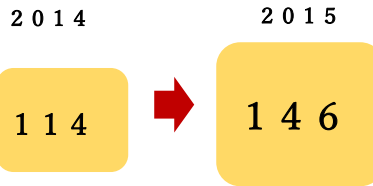

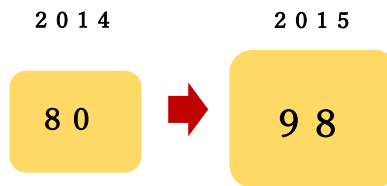


There is basic policy of LGBT

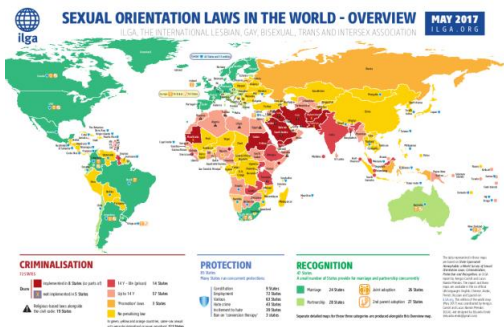


Compared with 2014, in 2015, 32 companies which have basic policy of LGBT increased.

Compared with 2014, 18 companies which have approach to LGBT increased.

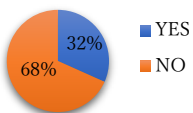


The map was drawn in 2017. It shows how different countries around the world have sexual orientation laws.

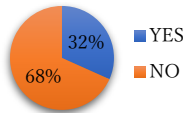
From this map, in Europe, Asia, North, Central and South America there are many countries which do not have a penalty for same-sex sexual acts.

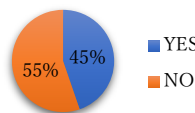
Do you know what LGBT stands for?



Do you know that Ochanomizu University have decided to accept the students who are transgender?



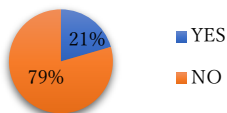
What city have legalize the same sex-marriage?



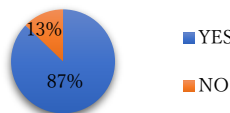
We conducted a survey of 100 students at Hosei University Kokusai High School.

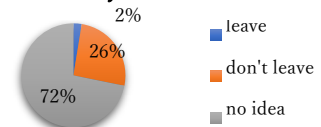
Do you know anyone around you who has come out as LGBT?



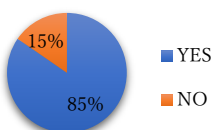
Do you think it's a good idea for LGBT people to come out?



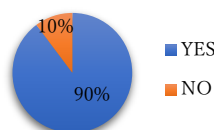
What would you do if your boyfriend/girlfriend confessed they are LGBT?
